Maribel Aber was most recently Vice President of the NASDAQ MarketSite and Global Events and Programs for NASDAQ OMX. Ms. Aber's responsibilities included: establishing the strategic direction and operations for the MarketSite, NASDAQ OMX's premier multimedia facility and state-of-the-art broadcast studio, located in the heart of Times Square. Ms. Aber spearheaded the implementation of the 2004 CNN Presidential Election Night Coverage, live from the NASDAQ MarketSite. Ms. Aber pioneered the idea of the remote opening bell and promoted them across the globe, including in: Beijing, Davos, London, Dubai, and in Mysore and Chennai, India. Ms. Aber also oversaw the redesign of NASDAQ OMX's flagship facility and directed the global events team responsible for such successful events as the London International Conference and most recently, NASDAQ OMX's first ever conference in Dubai, U.A.E.

In her role, Ms. Aber oversaw the development of innovative and unique marketing and branding opportunities from the NASDAQ MarketSite to bring heightened visibility and awareness for the more than 3900 companies that list on The NASDAQ Stock Market and the OMX. As a brand ambassador for NASDAQ OMX, Ms. Aber regularly hosted the televised NASDAQ Opening and Closing Bell ceremonies, and conducted interviews of visiting CEOs and dignitaries. Ms. Aber worked for the NASDAQ OMX for 13 years, where she served in several roles, spanning: regulatory, legal, advertising, and client services.

Ms. Aber is a graduate of the University of Virginia, and holds a B.A. in Foreign Affairs. She earned her J.D. from New York Law School.
